The proposed CCC replica barracks is to be located on the site of the museum at Quiet Dell. "We have worked hard to find an actual CCC barracks to be transported and set up on the museum campus, but have been unsuccessful. We are moving ahead with plans to construct a replica CCC barracks which would serve as a part of the museum and as a tourist attraction to the central West Virginia area." Anderson stated. We will be meeting with the Harrison County Commission which has recently taken over the properties on the proposed site. The next phase will be the groundbreaking and foundation phase.
